

FAQs on CUNYfirst STUDENT ACCOUNTS

1. How can I view my grades/transcript?

Log in to CUNYfirst and click on **HR/Campus Solutions**. Click on **Self Service** and then on **Student Center**. In the **Academics** section from the **Other Academic** dropdown box, select **Transcript: View Unofficial** and then click the **Go** icon. On the **View Unofficial Transcript** page, click the **Academic Institution** dropdown box icon and select Lehman College. Click the **Report Type** dropdown box icon; and then select **STUDENT UNOFFICIAL TRANSCRIPT**. Click the **view report** button. Your **Unofficial Transcript** will pop-up in .pdf file format to view, print or save as needed.

Note: Please do not press any other buttons or links while processing is taking place.

* if the transcript does not load, click on Student Center. In the Academics section from the Other Academic dropdown box, select Course History and then click the Go icon and the list of courses will appear as a grade report.

*Please make sure you disable the pop-up blocker from the website

2. I forgot my username; how can I find out what it is?

Go to https://home.cunyfirst.cuny.edu select First time users link to reclaim your account. Your username will be displayed after successfully setting your password.

3. I forgot my password; what do I do now?

Go to https://home.cunyfirst.cuny.edu select Forgot your Password link and type your username or EMPLID.

4. My answers to challenge questions are not working; I have tried multiple times. What do I do?

Go to https://home.cunyfirst.cuny.edu select First time users link to redo challenge questions and reset the password.

5. My CUNYfirst Account is locked; what do I do now?

Go to https://home.cunyfirst.cuny.edu select Forgot your Password link. Successfully changing your password will automatically unlock your account.

6. I have followed the steps above, but I am still having trouble with my account, what do I do?
