- Devise and complete, in consultation with a faculty advisor, an original plan of music theory research
- Find and evaluate scholarly writings about music analysis
- Use musical evidence to write persuasive analysis of music
- Cite sources consistently and appropriately according to the Chicago Manual of Style
- 4. <u>Rationale</u>: This course has long been part of the graduate music program, though somehow was overlooked in the CUNYfirst system upgrade and was not carried over. The course offers students the opportunity to pursue an independent research project related to music theory. It is an option for students enrolled in the Master of Liberal Studies program and is an advanced elective for students in the Master of Arts in Teaching program, who want to pursue an individual research project beyond the required general theory courses.
