


Configuring Android enabled devices for the new wireless network

(Note: screenshots are from Samsung Galaxy S III with Firmware 4.0.4)


1. Press the **Menu** button, and then tap **Settings**.



2. On the Settings screen, tap **Wireless & networks** and turn on **Wi-Fi**.




3. Tap "**lehman_college**" and then **Connect to network**. Then select **PEAP** and **MSCHAPv2**.



4. Enter your Lehman username in the Identity field. (Leave the Anonymous Identity field blank.)
5. Enter your Lehman password and Tap **Connect**.



6. The Wi-Fi status will display your connection to the “*lehman_college*” network.



Your device is now configured to connect to “*lehman_college*”. In the future, you may connect to “*lehman_college*” by simply selecting it from the list of available wireless networks and providing your login credentials.
