

Configuring Android enabled devices for the new wireless network

(Note: screenshots are from Samsung Galaxy S III with Firmware 4.0.4)

1. Press the **Menu** button, and then tap *Settings*.



2. On the Settings screen, tap Wireless & networks and turn on Wi-Fi.



3. Tap "lehman_college" and then Connect to network. Then select PEAP and MSCHAPv2.

- 5. Enter your Lehman password and Tap Connect.
