To qualify for the Myself Third Scholarship, you must:

- Have completed at least 50 hours of service in your community and/or school within 1 year of application.
- Be a high school senior scheduled to graduate in June 2009
- Be enrolled in or have completed at least one **College Now** course or workshop
- Submit a completed application including a typed essay on civic service, letter(s) of recommendation and official academic transcript.
- If selected, be able to provide proof of Fall 2009 enrollment and commit to participating in at least one community service project during your freshman year.
