**B. ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS FOR SENIOR COLLEGE PROGRAM**

To earn a Bachelor's Degree at Lehman College, SUNY Associate of Applied Science Degree graduates need to:

- Satisfy the Lehman College Required Core, Flexible Core, Lower Level College Option, and College Option components of the General Education curriculum.
- two writing intensive courses
- elective courses, if needed
- 90 liberal arts credits are required for the BA, 60 liberal arts credits for the BS and 30 Liberal Arts Credits for the BBA.

Determination of the 90 Liberal Arts credits required for the baccalaureate degree in accordance with New York State Education Department requirements will be made by Lehman College.

Westchester Community College graduates with the Associate of Applied Science Degree in Human Services will receive 60 credits toward the Bachelor of Arts in Social Work at Lehman College.

Total transfer credits granted toward the baccalaureate degree: 60

Total additional credits required at the senior college to complete baccalaureate degree: 62-64

### **E. Articulation Agreement Follow-Up Procedures**

#### **1. Procedures for reviewing, up-dating, modifying or terminating agreement:**

Lehman will inform Westchester Community College about the academic progress of transfer students.

#### **3. Sending and receiving college procedures for publicizing agreement, e.g., college catalogs, transfer advisers, Websites, etc.:**

Notice of articulation will be placed in the respective catalogues, recruiting brochures, and websites.

Respective transfer and academic advisors will be informed and provided with copies of this agreement.

The Lehman College Enrollment Management division will attend recruiting events on-campus at Westchester Community College regularly.
