B. ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS FOR SENIOR COLLEGE PROGRAM

Associate of Science Degree from Westchester Community College.

Westchester Community College graduates with the Associate of Science Degree in Human Services will receive 60 credits toward the Bachelor of Arts in Social Work at Lehman College. In addition, they will be deemed to have met all Required Core, Flexible Core, and Foreign Language College Option general education requirements at Lehman College.

To earn a Bachelor's Degree at Lehman College, SUNY Associate Degree graduates need to:

- complete at minimum 50% of the courses required for the major/minor in residence
- two upper-level College Option interdisciplinary courses
- two writing intensive courses
- elective courses, if needed.
- 90 liberal arts credits are required for the BA, 60 liberal arts credits for the BS and 30 Liberal Arts Credits for the BBA.

Determination of the 90 Liberal Arts credits required for the baccalaureate degree in accordance with New York State Education Department requirements will be made by Lehman College.

Total transfer credits granted toward the baccalaureate degree: 60

Total additional credits required at the senior college to complete baccalaureate degree: 64

E. Articulation Agreement Follow-Up Procedures

1. Procedures for reviewing, up-dating, modifying or terminating agreement:

This agreement will be reviewed annually by department chairs at both Westchester Community College and Lehman College and all relevant changes will be made as an amendment to this agreement. This agreement may be terminated at any time by either party.

2. Procedures for evaluating agreement, e.g., tracking the number of students who transfer under the articulation agreement and their success:

Lehman will inform Westchester Community College about the academic progress of transfer students.

3. Sending and receiving college procedures for publicizing agreement, e.g., college catalogs, transfer advisers, Websites, etc.:


Notice of articulation will be placed in the respective catalogues, recruiting brochures, and websites.


