General Stipulations

- □ Westchester Community College students who graduate with an A.A. or A.S. degree in Humanities/Social Sciences and with a cumulative GPA of 2.0 will be granted "junior" or upper-level status at Lehman College. [Admission to the New York State Teacher Certification Sequence requires an overall GPA of 2.75, with a 3.0 GPA in all Early Childhood or Childhood Education courses.]
- □ Westchester students who graduate with an A.A.S. degree in Early Childhood Education with a cumulative GPA of 2.0 will be granted "junior" or upper-level status at Lehman College. [Admission to the New York State Teacher Certification Sequence requires an overall GPA of 2.75, with a 3.0 GPA in all Early Childhood or Childhood Education courses.]
- Upon transferring into Lehman College, qualified Westchester graduates will be awarded up to a maximum of 60 credits earned at Westchester as applicable to specified programs and/or institutional requirements at Lehman College. WCC students will earn appropriate prerequisite standing for credits above the maximum of 60.
- □ SUNY Westchester graduates who hold either an AA or AS degree will be deemed to have fulfilled all lower division General Education requirements at Lehman College. [Students will be required to take the two upper division LEH courses.*]
- Courses transferred will receive full credit as awarded by SUNY Westchester even if the equivalent Lehman College course award is a different number of credits.
- □ Students, who have determined their future major, should consult the Lehman College degree sheets included in this document, to guide their choice of required courses and electives if they wish to apply them to the major. Each degree sheet indicates:
 - ➤ Which courses should be taken within the first two years of study at SUNY Westchester (See attachment)
 - ➤ Which courses will remain for completion during the second two years at Lehman College (See attachment)
 - ➤ Parallel Lehman College courses for which Westchester graduates will earn credit (See attachment)
 - Whether or not there is a minimum grade for courses required for the major: Admission to the New York State Teacher Certification Sequence requires an overall GPA of 2.75, with a 3.0 GPA in all Early Childhood or Childhood Education courses Admission to

the New York State Teacher Certification Sequence requires an overall GPA of 2.75, with a 3.0 GPA in all Early Childhood or Childhood Education courses.

> Whether courses not accepted by the major will earn elective credit toward graduation.

Each transferring student will be assigned a program faculty advisor at Lehman College, who will assist the student in charting a comprehensive academic plan allowing for graduation in the shortest time possible, usually two years of full-time study or its part-time equivalent.

Students who transfer from Westchester Community College to Lehman College are expected to adhere to general academic policies and procedures required for admission to the College, and to fulfill any particular requirements (regarding GPA, prerequisites, clinical experience, etc.) that may be in place for certain academic programs at the College. The Lehman College catalogue specifies, in detail, all relevant policies and procedures. Students will not be expected to meet adjusted requirements, if they differ from those as stated in this document upon the students' matriculation at Lehman College.

Specific Stipulations

Transfer students seeking degrees in the specific programs covered by this agreement will need to meet the requirements outlined in this document.

Both Westchester Community College and Lehman College agree to keep each other informed of program changes in a timely way.

Portfolio Requirement: Regardless of degree program, transfer students completing the equivalent of Lehman's education minor must present a comprehensive portfolio of assignments completed throughout the 12-credits of WCC education coursework. This portfolio will serve to document outcomes needed for the maintenance of Lehman's NCATE accreditation.

AA Humanities Transfers:

- 1. It is recommended that Art History (3), Music (3) and Foreign Language (6) requirements for NYS Certification be taken under WCC *Humanities* (3) and *Additional Humanities* (9).
- 2. It is recommended that three credits of American History be taken under WCC Behavioral/Social Science Electives.
- 3. WCC Free Electives should be used for the 12-credit Education Minor:

AA Social Science Transfers:

- 2. Students will need to complete 6 credits in Foreign Language for NYS Certification either at Lehman College or instead of Art and Music at WCC as above. (If Foreign Language is completed at WCC, Art and Music will be completed at Lehman)
- 3. WCC Free Electives should be used for the 12 credit Education Minor:

AAS Transfers:

- 1. Students will need a second semester of science at Lehman if two Math courses are taken at WCC, or a second semester of math at Lehman if two sciences are taken at WCC.
- 2. Students will need 6 credits of Foreign Language, 3 credits of Art History and 3 credits of Music to meet requirements for NYS Certification. Six of these 12 can be taken under WCC Humanities/Social Science (3) and Elective (3). Students will complete the remainder at Lehman.
- 3. One semester of American History is recommended.

Note: If a student selects Foreign Language at WCC, it is advisable he/she completes the second semester at WCC under the *Elective*, rather than to let semesters lapse between subsequent levels.
