CSI STRIKES DOWN LIGHTNING FOR TITLE

STATEN ISLAND, NY - In each of his nine seasons, College of Staten Island head coach Bill Cali's team has reached the CUNYAC Championship final, but for only the fourth time during that span, the Dolphins rewarded Cali with a title, beating Lehman College 8-3, on their home field.

The Dolphins led 1-0 after the bottom of the second inning when SS Anthony Hillery (Staten Island, NY) scored when senior C Michael Guarneri (Staten Island, NY) grounded into a double play. The Lightning evened the score in the top of the stanza when junior 3B Carlos Ramirez (New York, NY) tripled to lead off the inning and scored on a single from sophomore catcher Joharry Burgos (Bronx, NY).

But CSI took the lead again in the bottom of the third when 2B Andrew Fraschilla (Staten Island, NY) rounded home on a groundout by CF Eric Zinke (Staten Island, NY). Lehman bounced back in the top of the fifth with two runs. First OF Jonathan Duran (Bronx, NY) hit a sacrifice fly to center to score Ramirez who doubled, then Burgos, who singled scored on an infield error, as Lehman held a 3-2 lead.

The home team struck right back getting three runs in the next half inning. First DH Chris Hemmes (Staten Island, NY) scored on an error by the catcher, followed by an RBI single by Zinke that plated 1B Tom Wohlfit (Staten Island, NY). Zinke came home for a 5-3 lead on a wild pitch by Lehman starter Daniel Calcano, who yielded only six hits and three earned runs over six inning.

After that inning the Lightning couldn't stop the bleeding, giving up three more runs in the next two innings. In the seventh frame, a double by RF Jason Filoramo (Staten Island, NY) sent Zinke home. Two batters later, Hillery singled to score Filoramo. In the eighth, Zinke knocked in his third run of the game on a sacrifice fly. The 5'9" centerfielder finished 2-4 with two runs and three RBI in the championship game. Combine that with an excellent performance in the semifinals against Baruch and Zinke was 3-5 at the plate, while reaching base three more times via walks, with six runs and four RBI and two stolen bases.

"I just felt real comfortable at the plate today," said Zinke, the Tournament Most Valuable Player, who actually won a CUNY championship in 2001, as a freshman at Baruch, before transferring to his native borough school. "We've been building towards this all season."

CSI righthander Lino Isabel (Staten Island, NY) got the start, striking out five over 4 1/3 innings, surrendering all three Lehman runs. Then the duo of Kevin Biesty (Staten Island, NY) and Nick Secchini (Staten Island, NY) shut down the Lightning over the final 4 2/3 innings, yielding only 4 hits combined and no other baserunners. Biesty earned the victory (3-0) while Secchini pitched the final two innings in relief, allowing only one hit and striking out three.

CHAMPIONSHIP at THE COLLEGE OF STATEN ISLAND

Semifinals: #3 Lehman 8, #2 John Jay 3

Staten Island, NY - Lehman junior righty Mike Centeno gave up only six hits and two walks in a complete game victory, 8-3 over John Jay, to send the Lightning to the CUNYAC / Burger King Baseball Championship final for the second time in three seasons.

The Bloodhounds scored in their first at bat, when CUNYAC Player of the Year, sophomore CF Miguel Jaquez reached on an error and scored on a single by junior C John Tango. That was followed by a single by senior LF Paul Torre that scored senior 3B Angel Rivera for a 2-0 lead.

The Lightning didn't score until the top of the fifth inning when junior RF Jason Castillo walked and came around on a single by junior LF Hector Vallejo. They evened the score in the sixth inning when sophomore DH Christian Molina scored on a double by junior CF Jonathan Duran. Lehman broke the game open in the next inning when they added three more runs, followed by three more in the top of the ninth. Junior catcher Joharry Burgos finished the game 3-5 with one run batted in, while Castillo had two RBI for the Lightning.

Staten Island, NY - The College of Staten Island topped Baruch in the semifinals 13-1, to advance to the CUNYAC / Burger King Championship final for the ninth straight season, every year under head coach Bill Cali.

The Dolphins scored two runs in the bottom of the first inning, without benefit of a hit on two walks, two stolen bases, a wild pitch and an infield error. In the next inning, the Dolphins added three runs on RBI extra base hits by sophomore 1B Tom Wohlfitt, junior CF Eric Zinke and sophomore RF Jason Filaromo for a 5-0 lead.

Meanwhile, CSI junior righthanded starter Ted Maceda shut down the Bearcats on two hits over the first seven innings. He ended up yielding only five hits, no walks and four strikeouts over nine innings.

Baruch scored their only run when junior 2B Edwin Fernandez scored on a ground out by freshman outfielder Emil Geosits.

2003 KNICKERBOCKER & ECAC CHAMPIONSHIPS

DOLPHINS ONLY TEAM TO ADVANCE PAST CUNY SEASON

STATEN ISLAND, NY- After defeating Lehman College by a score of 8-3 claiming the 2003 CUNY Athletic Conference baseball championship title, the College of Staten Island Dolphins faced off against Manhattanville College in the semifinals of the Knickerbocker Championships.

The Dolphins were shut out by the Valiants 9-0, who were later defeated by Mount St. Mary in the finals, 2-1. Knickerbocker second team all-star Sophomore Jason Filoramo (OF) and sophomore Chris Hemmes (DH) had two hits each while Kickerbocker first team all-star Tom Wohlfit (1B) contributed one.

Knick Pitcher of the Year sophomore Nick Secchini had a strong outing striking out 10 while giving up seven hits, three earned runs and only one walk in eight innings pitched but was let down on the defensive end as the Dolphins committed a season high, seven errors in the game.

Four days later the Dolphins played in the ECAC semifinals for the ninth time with freshman right-hander Jesse Colliton taking the mound against Farleigh Dickinson University-Florham.

Starter Jesse Colliton got hit hard in the first inning yielding four earned runs forcing Staten Island to play catchup. 1B Tom Wohlfit singled home left fielder John DeFrancesco for the Dolphins first run in the top of the third but FDU rallied back for two more runs in the bottom of the fourth. In the top of the eighth, CSI scored their other run when CUNY tournament MVP Eric Zinke knocked home 3B Anthony Hillery.

The loss marked the second straight season that FDU eliminated CSI from the ECAC championships. The Dolphins finished their season 20-16.

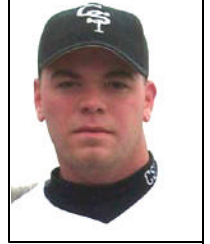
