



CUNY Athletic Conference 2002-03 Year In Review WOMEN'S TENNIS

2002 CUNYAC / Hospital For Special Surgery Championships HUNTER HOLDS OFF BROOKLYN FOR 10TH EVER TITLE

Flushing Meadows, NY - Hunter College earned its third consecutive CUNY Athletic Conference Women's Tennis Tournament Championship at the USTA National Tennis Center by holding off Brooklyn College by a 46-43 margin. With nine flights up for grabs, the Hawks won four singles championships and one doubles title to take the crown for the 10th time in the last 13 years.

"I think it was more necessary to win this year," said jubilant Hunter head coach Jocelyn Cruz. "We were 7-0 in CUNY and it all seemed to come together. It's my fourth season now as coach and the teamwork just gets better every year."

The top seed in the tournament, Hunter senior Maureen McBride, beat Brooklyn freshman Stella Rubina (Brooklyn, NY) in the #1 singles final 6-1, 6-3. A two-sport star (swimming) from Ridgefield, CT, McBride wraps up her career with a 25-0 CUNY singles record after having won the championship at the #2 flight the previous two seasons.

"Maureen is a great asset to our team. She inspires the younger players while providing consistency at the top position," said Cruz. "She gets to the net often and that's what we work on in practice. It's a goal the entire team has been working for. I'm sad to see her graduate."

In singles, the Hawks also won the number three, four, and five flights. Junior Marilyn Penaco (Bronx, NY) was victorious for the second time in three seasons, beating College of Staten Island senior Nadine Newbold (Staten Island, NY) in the #3 final 6-2, 6-3. In a pair of all-sophomore showdowns, Hunter's Soo Jung Kim (Eureka, CA) got past Brooklyn's Yolanda Hillocks (Brooklyn, NY) 5-7, 6-1, 6-4 at #4 singles while teammate Shirley Vargas (Bronx, NY) won her first gold medal over Brooklyn's Amanda Rosario (Brooklyn, NY) 7-6, 1-6, 6-4 at #5 singles.

To cap off her day, Kim captured the #2 doubles championship with classmate Rachel Swygert (Las Vegas, NV) by a 6-3, 6-1 score against Hillocks and freshman Renee Pointdujour (Brooklyn, NY). Penaco and Vargas also netted crucial points for the Hawks by reaching their doubles finals, but both came up short as the day came to a close. The tandem of McBride and Penaco, which had won 18 consecutive CUNY doubles matches over the last three seasons, fell to the John Jay duo of junior Jackie Albuja (Houston, TX) and sophomore Leisel-Ann Amow (Brooklyn, NY) 6-1, 1-6, 6-2 at first doubles.

Albuja also topped Pointdujour for the #2 singles crown 3-6, 6-3, 7-6. She played spirited tennis all weekend, leading the third-place Bloodhounds to their best finish in memory. "I guess I find a way to win these matches. I really feel that I deserve the singles title more than before. It was a great match and I worked harder getting to every ball," she said.

Another double gold medalist (alongside Albuja and Kim) was Brooklyn sophomore Dana Caputo (Brooklyn, NY). She won the #6 singles championship via a walkover thanks to her scheduled opponent's inability to attend Saturday matches due to religious observances. Caputo later paired with sophomore teammate Elizabeth Mickhly (Brooklyn, NY) to take third doubles over Hunter's Vargas and junior Corina Muresan (Maspeth, NY) 7-6, 6-1.

"Elizabeth and I play very well together and this match proved as such," said Caputo. "It's great to see hard work pay off at the CUNY Championships."

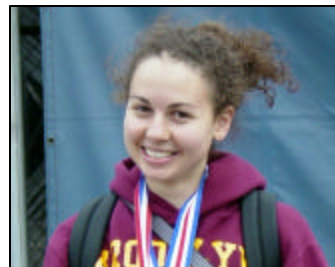
