## Lehman's Award-winning Coaches Announce Summer Basketball Camp

City University of New York 2001-02 basketball "Coaches of the Year" Steven Schulman (Men's Division) and Eric Harrison (Women's Division) will once again be holding their annual Basketball Camp at the APEX on the Lehman College campus.

The camp, which is open to boys and girls ages 6-17, will operate this summer the week of Monday August 12 through Friday August 16. Both believe strongly that it is important to give back to youth in the Bronx Community.

"We spend all season working with our college athletes so it is really special to have a chance to work with young kids. We enjoy teaching them the basics" said Coach Schulman.

The camp focuses on teaching youngsters the fundamentals of the game of basketball. Skills such as shooting, dribbling and passing are emphasized along with teaching teamwork and good sportsmanship.

"What makes our camp unique is that there is something for players of all levels, from the beginner to the advanced player," says Coach Harrison. Harrison, in keeping with Coach Schulman's enthusiasm, added "We love seeing kids smile as they learn how to dribble the ball up and down the court or when they make their first basket. That, in a nutshell, is why we continue with the camp every year."

Coaches Schulman and Harrison are assisted by the camp staff made up of both of the varsity team's assistant coaches, as well as many of the Lehman Lightning basketball players. The kids really enjoy the opportunity to meet with, learn from and play along with the college players and, according to Ivelisse Rosario, starting point guard for the Lady Lightning, the pleasure is reciprocal.

"There is nothing I enjoy more than working with young kids," she said. "It is such a rewarding experience to give back to the next generation. The most that I could hope for is that I might inspire a kid to integrate sports into their lives."

Every year Coaches Schulman and Harrison have the pleasure of bringing to basketball campers special guest speakers. Last year women's national "Player of the Year" Sue Bird from the University of Connecticut spoke at the camp.

"It is fantastic for the kids to get a chance to learn from someone as talented as Sue Bird," commented Harrison, "We will, once again, have some outstanding speakers this year."

The camp runs from 9 to 4 and the camp staff will be available until 5 for pick-up. The one-week session costs \$150 per child. Those who sign up before June 12 will receive a \$50 discount. Campers may choose to bring their own lunches or buy lunches through the camp store. 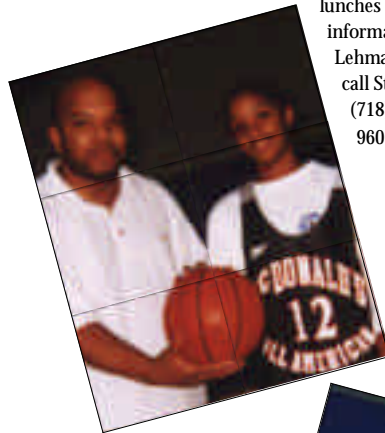

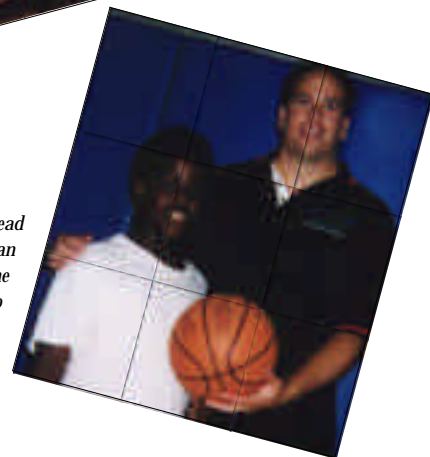
