Lehman's Sekani Francis Named D3 Hoops Third Team All-American

Sterling, VA. --D3hoops.com has announced the fifth annual D3hoops.com All-American team for Division III basketball, and Lehman College senior center Sekani Francis was selected as a third team All-American.

Francis, the two time CUNY conference Most Valuable Player, led the CUNY conference with 19.3 points per game to go along with 12.3 rebounds per game. The 6'10" center led Lehman to a 14-13 overall record, and an appearance in the ECAC post-season tournament.

"This is a great honor," said

Francis. "To be selected as an all-american, is a testament to the hard work and commitment that I have given for the past two seasons."

Kyle Merick, a guard out of Lincoln University (PA) was named as the D3 Hoops Player of the Year.
