(LEH 355: Studies in Philosophy, is NOT a College Option for this Major).
- [2] Students who have completed an AAS degree may have additional general education courses to complete Note: At least 9 credits should be worth of 300 or 400 level PHI courses.
- [3] 6 Credits from Category 3: PHI 231, PHI 237, PHI 349, PHI 353, PHI 354, PHI 355, or PHI 356.
