



[1] No more than two courses in one discipline may be used to satisfy Flexible Core requirements.

[2] These are variable topics courses, where each section covers a special topic. Take two courses with two different numbers. Pre-requisite: You must have achieved 60 credits and declared your major. Integration Courses: LEH 351: Studies in Science & Applied Perspectives, LEH 352: Studies in Literature, LEH 354: Studies in Historical Studies, LEH 355: Studies in Philosophy, Theory & Abstract Thinking. (LEH 353: Studies in Arts, is NOT a College Option for this Major).

[3] Ensemble: 6 Credits in total from the following list- MSP 100, MSP 201, MSP 202, MSP 203, MSP 204, MSP 205, MSP 206, MSP 207 or MSP 208.

[4] We strongly recommend clustering 12-15 elective credits to obtain a minor or certificate that complements your general and major field of study. The choice of the minor or certificate depends on your interest and should be coordinated with advisors. Check out more information on Minors or Certificates with your advisor.

[5] Performance Instruction: 6 Credits in total from the following list- MSP 166, MSP 167, MSP 168, MSP 169, MSP 170, MSP 171, MSP 172, MSP 185, MSP 190, MSP 191, MSP 192, MSP 21, MSP 226 or MSP 227.

[6] Music electives to be taken from the following courses: MSH 350: Topics in Ethnomusicology, MSH 369: History of Jazz, MSH 370: American Popular Music, MST 221: Fundamentals of Film Music, MST 245: Introduction to Music Therapy, MST 246: Music and the Brain, MST 316: Orchestration II, MST 318: Form and Analysis II, MST 319: Composition I, MST 320: Composition II, MST 321: Creating Music with Computers, MST 322: Recording Techniques and Studio Production, MST 323: Scoring for Media, MST 370: Music Internship, MST 371: Practicum in Music Therapy, MSP 230: Piano for Music Teachers, MSP 445: Conducting, and MSP 446: Conducting Advanced.

NOTE: Writing Intensive Sections: Complete 4 sections designated as writing-intensive, 3 prior to earning 60 credits and 1 following. These sections may be searched by class attribute and are offered in General Education, major, minor and elective courses.
