Liberal Arts Electives Option: DNC 420, ENG 226, ENG 312, ENG, 334, ENG 348, THE 238, THE 243, THE 3280, THE 332, THE 408, THE 439, THE 440, THE 442, THE 443, THE 445 or THE 454.
[5] We strongly recommend clustering 12-15 elective credits to obtain a minor or certificate that complements your general and major field of study.
