



GRE[®] Fee Reduction Program for the Unemployed

ETS offers a limited number of GRE[®] fee reductions to individuals who are unemployed. The fee reductions are available on a first come, first-served basis to those who meet the eligibility requirements below. Individuals meeting the eligibility requirements can take the GRE[®] General Test for 50 percent of the full test fee.

Eligibility Requirements:

- You must be a United States citizen or resident alien and eighteen (18) years or age or older.
- You must be currently unemployed and have become unemployed within the past six months.
- You must be planning to take the GRE General Test in the United States, Puerto Rico, Guam or U.S. Virgin Islands.
- You must be able to submit a copy of an Unemployment Benefits Statement from the past 90 days as proof of unemployment.
