31 **1. Approval of the Minutes**

32 A motion was made and seconded to adopt the minutes of the Senate meeting of April 3, 2013.

33 The minutes were approved by a unanimous voice vote.

35 **2. Announcements and Communications—**

- 36 a. 1. President Fernández reported that a press conference will take place tomorrow at 11 a.m.,
37 outside of Gate 8, in support of the Dream Act. President Fernández, Fordham University
38 President Father Joseph M. McShane, and Assemblyman Francisco P. Moya will be the
39 speakers. Also, this is the time of year for receptions, events and activities.

40 2. Concerning the budget, at least 13 new teaching positions will be allocated to Lehman
41 College. Some positions are left over from unsuccessful 2012 searches that will be filled this
42 year. We anticipate a healthy recoupment effort this new academic year.

43 3. The College will be conferring two honorary degrees at commencement this year. Dr.
44 Frances Beinecke, President of the National Resources Defense Council, and Father Fernando
45 Picó, a renowned historian on Puerto Rico, are the recipients. The President encourages all to
46 attend.

47 4. Dr. Fernández thanked all the members of the Senate and wished the students well on their
48 finals and graduation.

51 Mr. Michael Olivencia, chair of the Student Legislative Assembly (SLA), presented the report.

137 Political Science; and from the Department of Social Work. There is an experimental course
138 nestled in the proposal from the Department of Earth, Environmental and Geospatial Sciences

139 as an information item. The proposals were moved and approved by unanimous voice vote.

154 **g. Campus Life and Facilities—**

155 1. Prof. Deborah Sanders, the committee chair, stated that there is no report but that the next
156 Campus Life and Facilities meeting is scheduled for May 15th at 3:30 p.m. in Shuster 018.

158 **h. Budget and Long Range Planning—**

159 1. Prof. Hai-Ping Cheng, the committee chair, presented the report. See Attachment VI.

161 **i. University Faculty Senate Report—**

162 1. Prof. Peter Alexanderson presented his final report as the University Faculty Senate
163 representative to the Senate. He stated that at the April 9th meeting, Vice Chancellor for
164 Facilities, Planning, Construction and Management, Iris Weinshall, presented a report on
165 CUNY 2020, which was modeled after the SUNY 2020 report. Prof. Alexanderson indicated
166 that funds have been freed up to encourage competition in CUNY colleges' proposals, with the
167 goal of job creation in New York State. The grant money is in the \$5-10 million range. The
168 application will be released in May. There will be preliminary submissions, guidance will be
169 provided, and then the final submission in September. The award selection will take place in

171 the Fall. The most favorably-viewed applications will be collaborative and will have matching
172 funds. There will be more details on the University Faculty Senate website.

173 2. Among other matters addressed at the meeting was a resolution objecting to the Pathways
174 Core which passed with one nay and no abstentions.

175 3. The University Faculty Senate will hold at-large elections at the next meeting, May 7th, for
176 which there will be 5 positions.

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

Talking Points

The Literature specialization's electives fall into four groups: Shakespeare, Post-Colonial Literature, Writing courses, and a broad range of Literature courses (from ENG 336 Children's Literature, to ENG 347 Western Narrative, to ENG 463 Literary Criticism and Theory). Adding the existing but forgotten course, ENG 337 Irish Literature, to this last group of Literature elective broadens our offerings and ensures that a popular course is regularly filled.

The same rationale explains the inclusion of a literature elective from any department in the School of Arts and Humanities. The A&H literature option also increases our many students' chances of finding a course to complete the Major without having to delay graduation. Finally, the A&H literature option encourages English students to complement their Major work with a bit of comparative literary study. (A Humanities elective option also existed in the past and was accidentally lost during the Department's curricular overhaul in 2011.)

The substitution of ENG 300 for the General Education II requirement for the English/ECCE Major has been removed because of changes in the College's General Education structure. The substitution was originally put in place to enable students to fulfill their Gen Ed and English/ECCE Major requirements within the 120-credit graduation limit. The reduced number of credits in Gen Ed obviates any need to limit credits in the Major.

4. Rationale: The changes in the Professional Writing and Creative Writing Minors are practical corrections to the Department's 2011 curricular overhaul. Each of these two Minors originally asked students to take three introductory 300-level courses, but did not take into account that the Department does not regularly offer all six of these courses. Each Minor also made it impossible for a Creative Writing student who wanted to develop her poetry to take ENW 328 Advanced Poetry, or for a Professional Writing student who wanted to hone his grant-writing skills to take ENW 334 Grant and Proposal Writing. The proposed changes correct these problems by requiring students to do three things—to stick with the 200-level introductory course in each Minor, to take only two of the three basic courses offered, and to feel free to take any English course of their choice to round out their Minor.

CURRICULUM CHANGE

1. **Type of Change:** New course
2. **Course Description:** **POL 4720 Model United Nations.** *3 hours, 3 credits. (maximum 6 credits).* Practical understanding of the United Nations through participating in a simulation exercise known as the Model UN Conference. Topics will vary from year to year, but the course requires students to write a country fact sheet, a position paper, and draft resolutions to be used in the simulation exercise. **PREREQ:** Instructor's permission.
3. **Rationale:** The proposed course serves as a practice-oriented course in the understanding of the operations of the United Nations. It will help Lehman students participate in the Model UN Conference held annually in Manhattan and develop not only the detailed knowledge about specific topics the United Nations has been concerned with but also important skills, such as briefing, writing memoranda, policy statements and resolutions, debating, thinking strategically, and building alliances. This course serves those students who have an interest in international security and development, conflict resolution, justice, order, human needs, and human capabilities.
4. **Learning Objectives:** Students will:
 - a. Understand the history, principles, and operations of the United Nations.
 - b. Develop practical skills by writing memoranda, policy statements, and resolutions as well as learning modes of engagement with collaborative and conflict situations.
 - c. Develop the ability to analyze local and global issues in terms of the fundamental concepts of human rights, human security, and human development.

CURRICULUM CHANGE

1. Type of change: New Course

2. Course Description: SWK 2410, *3 hours, 3 credits*. Social Work Practice with Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual and Transgender (LGBT) Clients. Policy and social issues affecting the lives of LGBT populations and their families. Topics include social work practice and the resilience of diverse LGBT populations in the face of social stigma and oppression.

3. Rationale: Since the founding of the BA Social Work program at Lehman College, there has never been an elective course dedicated to the issues of working with the LGBT population. As the mission of the social work program is to educate students to work in urban social service settings with diverse populations, it is important to offer them the opportunity for focused learning in regard to social work practice issues related to LGBT individuals and their families.

4. Learning Objectives:

- Recognize and manage personal values in a way that allows professional values to guide practice.
- Analyze and deconstruct the extent to which societal structures and values may present opportunities to maximize potential; oppress, marginalize, or alienate; and create or enhance privilege and power.
- Be sufficiently self-aware to eliminate the influence of personal biases and values in working with diverse groups.
- Recognize and communicate an understanding of the importance of differences in shaping life experiences.
- Participate in practices that advance social and economic justice.
- Analyze, formulate and advocate for policies that advance social well-being.
- Substantively and affectively prepare for practice with individuals, families, groups, organizations, and communities.
- Use empathy and other interpersonal skills.
- Assess client strengths and limitations.
- Develop mutually agreed-on intervention goals and objectives.
- Negotiate, mediate, and advocate for clients.
