A quorum was not present. All votes taken were unanimous.

1. The minutes of the meeting of March 02, 2011 were approved.
2. The committee approved the Distribution Calendar for fall 11-spring 12, 2011.
3. Proposals from the Dept. of Economics and Business to create new courses ACC 445 and ACC 446 and to change the course description of ACC 342 were approved.
4. Proposals from the Dept. of Economics and Business to change the degree requirements of the 42 credit major in Accounting and the 34 credit major in Economics were approved.
5. Proposals from the Dept. of Economics and Business to change the degree requirements of the 46 credit Bachelor of Business Administration (BBA) and the 67 credit major in Accounting were approved, pending revisions.
6. Proposals from the Dept. of Economics and Business to create new courses BBA 345 and ACC 346 were sent back to the Dept.
7. A proposal from the Dept. of English to offer ENW 300 as an experimental course was approved.
8. The committee approved proposals from the Dept. of Sociology to create new courses Soc 248 and Soc 335.
9. Proposals from the Dept of Health Sciences to create new courses DFN 340 and EXS 425 were approved.
10. The committee approved proposals from the Department of Early Childhood and Childhood Education to change the Program Requirements for Professional Work, the Program Requirements for The Early Childhood Certification Sequences (Birth to Grade 2) and the Program Requirements for the Childhood Certification Sequences (Grades 1-6), pending minor editing.
11. A proposal from the Department of Early Childhood and Childhood Education to

create a new course ECE 434 was approved.

12. A proposal from the Department of Early Childhood and Childhood Education to create a new course DEC 483 was approved, pending minor editing.
