

Graduate Admissions

Bilingual Extension grades Birth – 2nd grade OR 1st grade – 6th grade.

Advanced Certificate

This program is designed for Bilingual Teachers who hold New York State Birth- 2nd grade **OR** 1st grade - 6th grade; who are proficient in English and in a home language other than English, [Spanish for now]; and who seek a bilingual extension to teach their certification area in both languages.

ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

- An undergraduate or master's degree index of at least 3.0.
- New York State early childhood or childhood teacher certification grades Birth to grade 6.
- One (1) letter of recommendation.
- Demonstrate proficiency in English and in the home language other than English by completing an interview and career essays in both languages.
- Have successfully completed a course in multicultural perspectives (at least 3 credits). Candidates may take ESC 769 or another course selected in consultation with the adviser to meet this requirement.
- Meet additional Department, College, and State requirements, if any.

CERTIFICATE REQUIREMENTS

Students must consult with an adviser in the Advanced Certificate: Bilingual Extension Birth-Grade 6 program before beginning their studies. During their first semester, matriculated students are required to plan their graduate program with the adviser. All candidates must complete the curriculum outlined below. In order to recommend for the Bilingual Extension, candidates must complete the Advanced Certificate: Bilingual Extension Birth - Grade 6 program with a cumulative of 3.0 or better, pass the Bilingual Education Assessment (BEA), and meet any additional New York.
