#### **SmartBoard Student Workshops:**

Our SmartBoard workshops continue to be of tremendous value to our students. The SmartBoard workshops assist our students in their teaching skills, improve their knowledge and use of technology in the classroom and assist in job searches when resumes identify they have SmartBoard Certification. Our instructors work closely with the SoE Educational Technology Coordinator to make the workshops specifically meet the needs of our students. We compress 10 hours of training into 4 weeks and have determined that the best time to offer the workshops are during the Winter/January and Summer/June sessions. We are requesting fewer workshop cycles this year to help lower our recurring costs.

**TaskStream Accounts:** To meet national accreditation standards (CAEP), the School of Education is required to track student data from the point of admissions through New York State Teacher Certification through to graduation and finally to alumni data. Our data collection requires more than what is available from the college and requires students to upload key assignments and assessments. Additionally, we use Taskstream as an integrated system for candidates to collect evidence of their work in student teaching to prepare for the edTPA.
