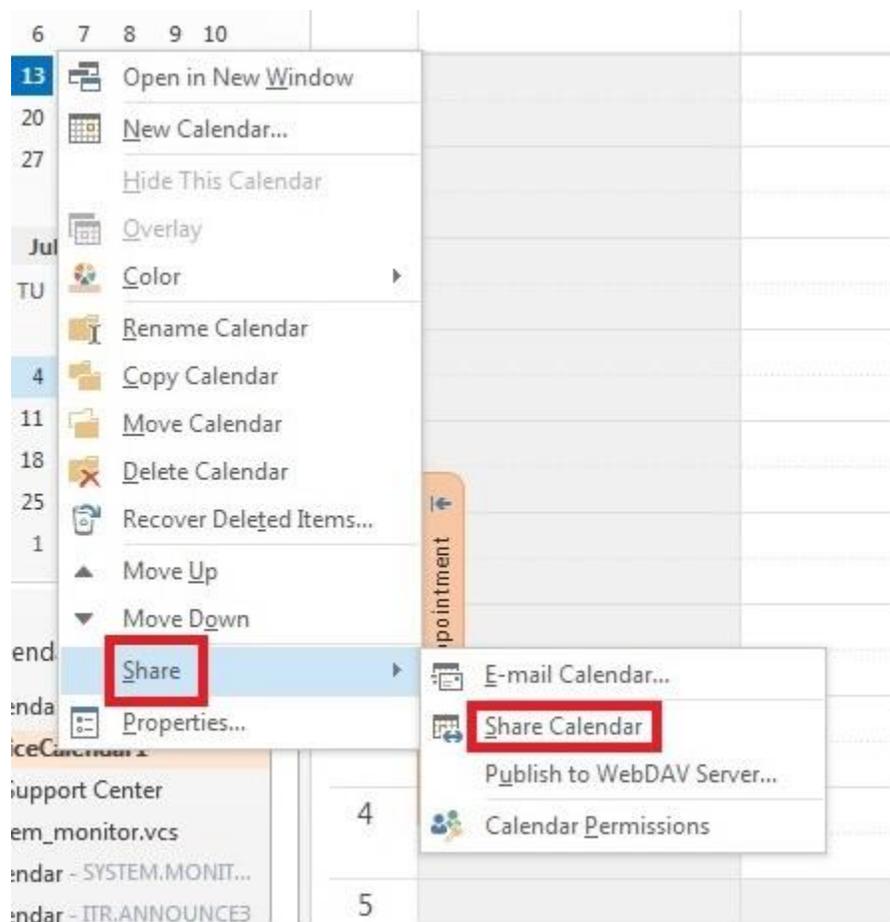


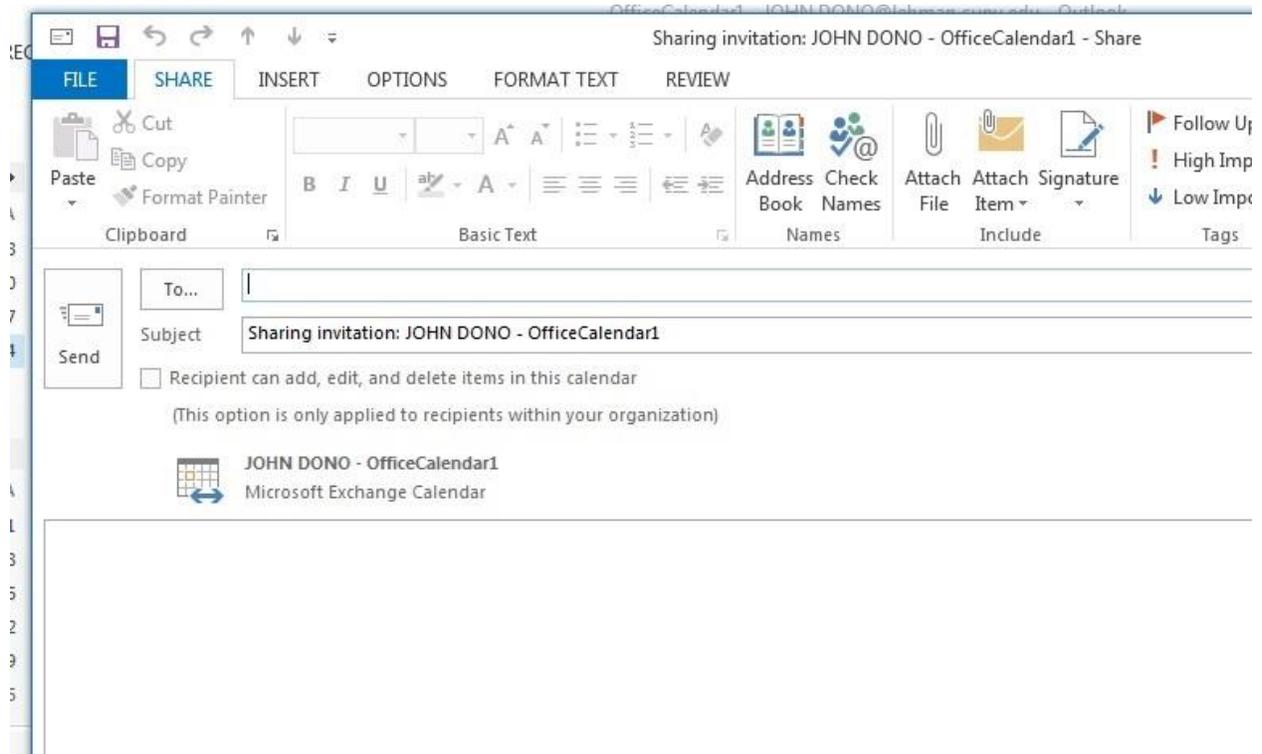
# Error Message When Sending an Invite to Share an Exchange Calendar

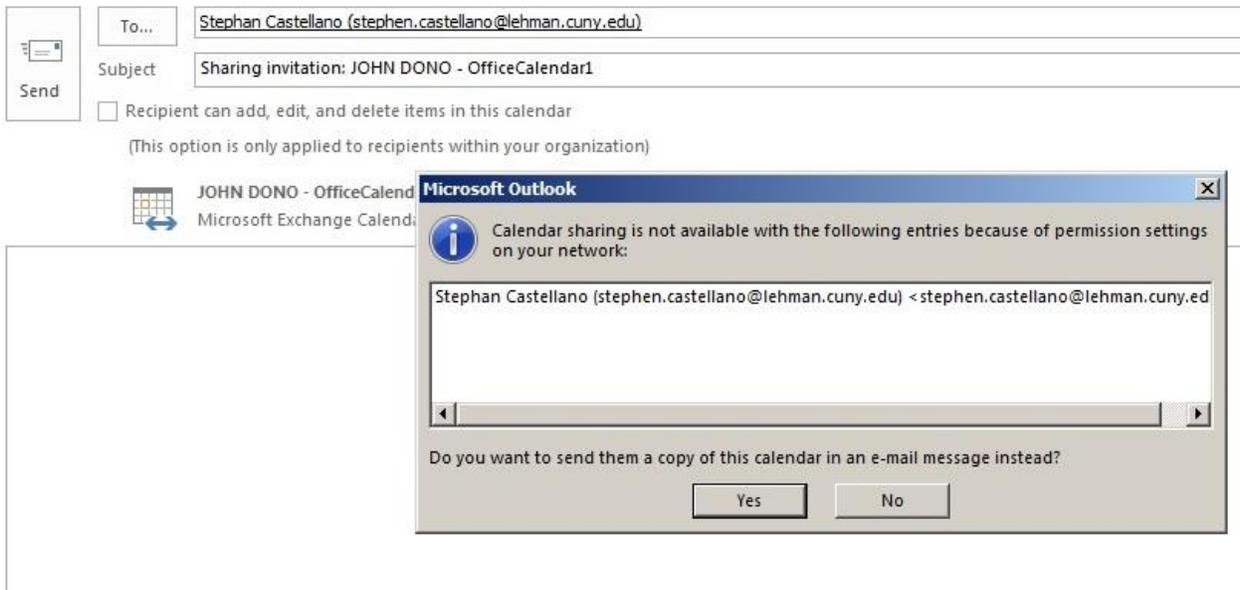
Staff and faculty with Lehman Exchange email accounts may share one or more of their calendars with other Lehman Exchange users. One way to share a calendar is to right click on the calendar name, then select **Share | Share Calendar** from the context menu.



An email invite compose window will open:

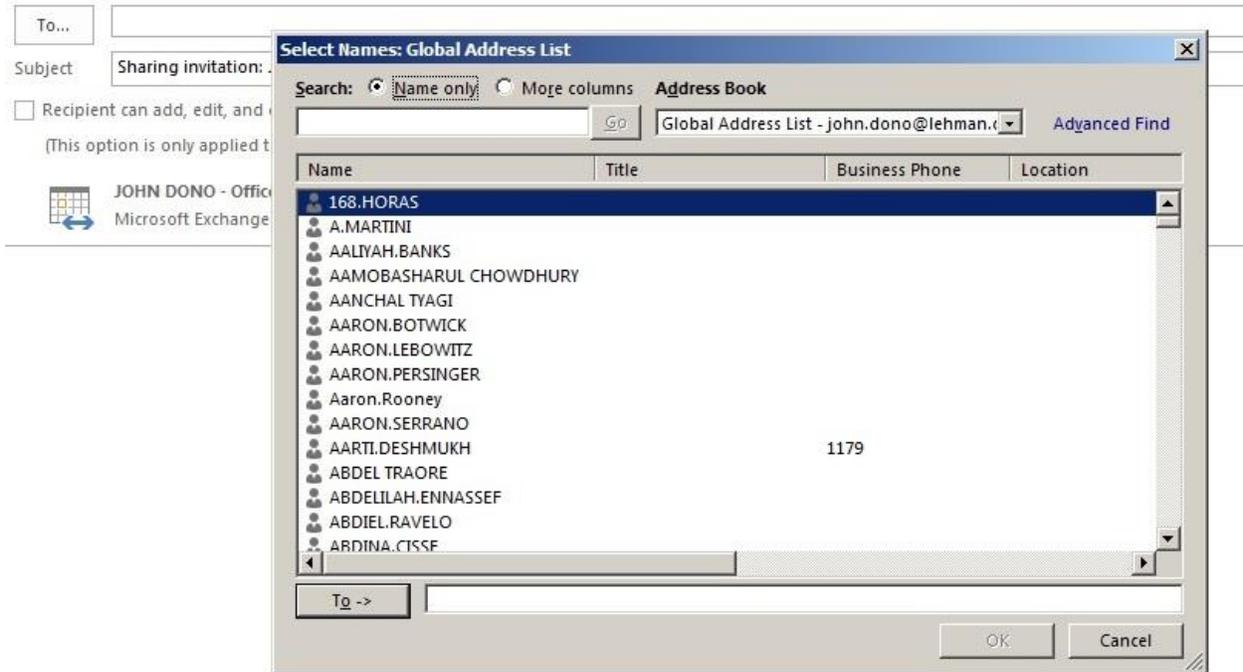


As you start to type in the **To:** field, Outlook's autocomplete feature will search for matching entries in your contacts and/or history. If you then select **Send** to invite a colleague with the found address, you may receive the following or similar error message:



The email address format retrieved from your contacts and/or history is not compatible with the format required by the calendar invite. Note that you see the name in standard display format followed by the fully-qualified email address in parentheses.

The solution is to click on the **To** button and select the user from the Global Address List. This will ensure that the format of the userid in the **To** field is compatible with the calendar invite.



Be sure that the **Name only** radio button is selected. Type the first few letters of the name of person you are looking for in the text box.

Select **To**, then **OK** to paste the userid in the invite.

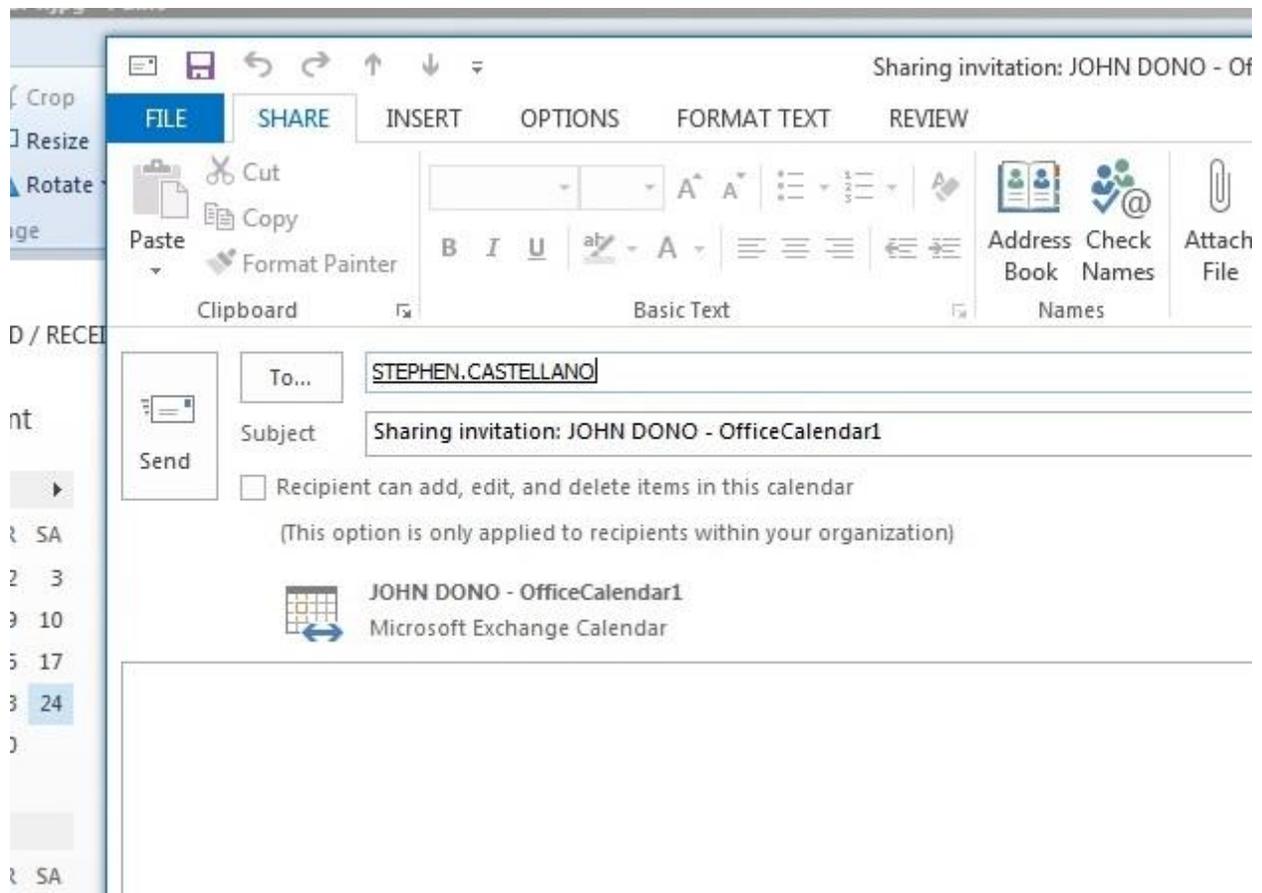
