

Dear Faculty,

Professors Sarah Hoiland (Sociology) of Hostos Community College and Esther Wilder (Sociology) of Lehman College invite full-time faculty from across the disciplines at CUNY's 3 Bronx schools (Bronx Community College, Hostos Community College and Lehman College) to participate in a faculty development program to learn about strategies for infusing quantitative reasoning into their teaching. The program also offers the opportunity for participating faculty to be involved with a community of CUNY faculty who are committed to undergraduate education. This project is supported by a grant from the National Science Foundation (NSF) and faculty participants will receive \$2,000 for their successful completion of an 8-unit predominantly online program during the summer of 2017 or the 2017-2018 academic year. A two-day introductory session will be held during the summer of 2017 and a capstone conference will be held during the summer of 2018. The application deadline is April 7.
