CUNY on the Concourse, a collaborative effort of the three City University of New York colleges in the Bronx – Lehman College, Hostos Community College and Bronx Community College – offers credit and non-credit courses in health career preparation, technology, business, college preparation, English as a Second Language, foreign languages, computer classes for children and after-school classes for high school students.

• Health Career Preparation

With an increase in demand for health care workers in the Bronx, CUNY on the Concourse is offering a wide range of preparation courses as well as core courses leading to degrees in nursing, health care administration, radiology technology, dental hygiene, dietetics and many more. Courses to upgrade skills of health care workers are planned.

Certificate Programs

Fourteen non-credit certificate programs are offered in office and business management, medical office operations, computer technology, surveying and mapping technology, construction technology and pre-nursing for high school students.

College and Test Preparation

Classes offered include GED, SAT and TOEFL preparation and preparation for the CUNY Skills Assessment Tests.

Credit-Bearing Program

A major endeavor is a managed care program carrying college credit.

Language Institute

English as a Second Language classes are available to children and adults with full-time, part-time and intensive weekend schedules. Spanish, French, American Sign Language and foreign languages for health care personnel are scheduled.

High School Academy

High school students may enroll in after-school classes in reading, writing, mathematics, English as a Second Language, foreign languages, SAT preparation and the sciences.

Junior Academy

Computer workshops for children in kindergarten through the ninth grade are offered at all levels.

Special Interests

Personal financial management and guitar classes are scheduled for the fall 2002 semester with additional classes covering other topics planned for future semesters.

Centrally located in the Bronx at 2501 Grand Concourse at Fordham Road in the former Alexander's/Caldor's building, CUNY on the Concourse offers state-of-the-art computer labs, classrooms and a nursing lab.
