

PROGRAM DETAILS

- 500 CUNY and SUNY students will travel to Puerto Rico for two weeks to help with rebuilding efforts
 - Earn 3 credits (tuition waived)
 - Travel expenses paid (airfare, lodging, food)
 - \$500 stipend
- Applications available through CUNY Service Corps site



APPLICATIONS DUE MAY 13

- **Students must:**
 - **Be matriculated in a degree program at a CUNY college at time of application**
 - **Be currently enrolled in Spring 2018**
 - **Be planning to enroll in Fall 2018**
 - **Be in good academic standing at their college and have a GPA of at least 2.5**
 - **Have earned at least 24 college credits by end of Spring 2018 (18 credits for community college students)**
 - **Have the required documentation for domestic travel**
