## **E. ARTICULATION AGREEMENT FOLLOW-UP PROCEDURES**

### **1. Procedures for reviewing, updating, modifying or terminating agreement:**

When either of the degree programs involved in this agreement undergoes a change, the agreement will be reviewed and revised accordingly by faculty from each institution's respective departments, selected by their Chairpersons.

### **2. Procedures for evaluating agreement, i.e., tracking the number of students who transfer under the articulation agreement and their success:**

Each semester Lehman College will provide Borough of Manhattan Community College with the following information: a) the number of BMCC students who applied to the program; b) the number of BMCC students who were accepted into the program; c) the number of BMCC students who enrolled and; d) the aggregate GPA of these enrolled students.

### **3. Sending and receiving college procedures for publicizing agreement, e.g., college catalogs, transfer advisers, websites, etc.:**

This articulation agreement will be published on the Borough of Manhattan Community College website and the Lehman College website. Transfer advisers at BMCC will promote this agreement with eligible students.
