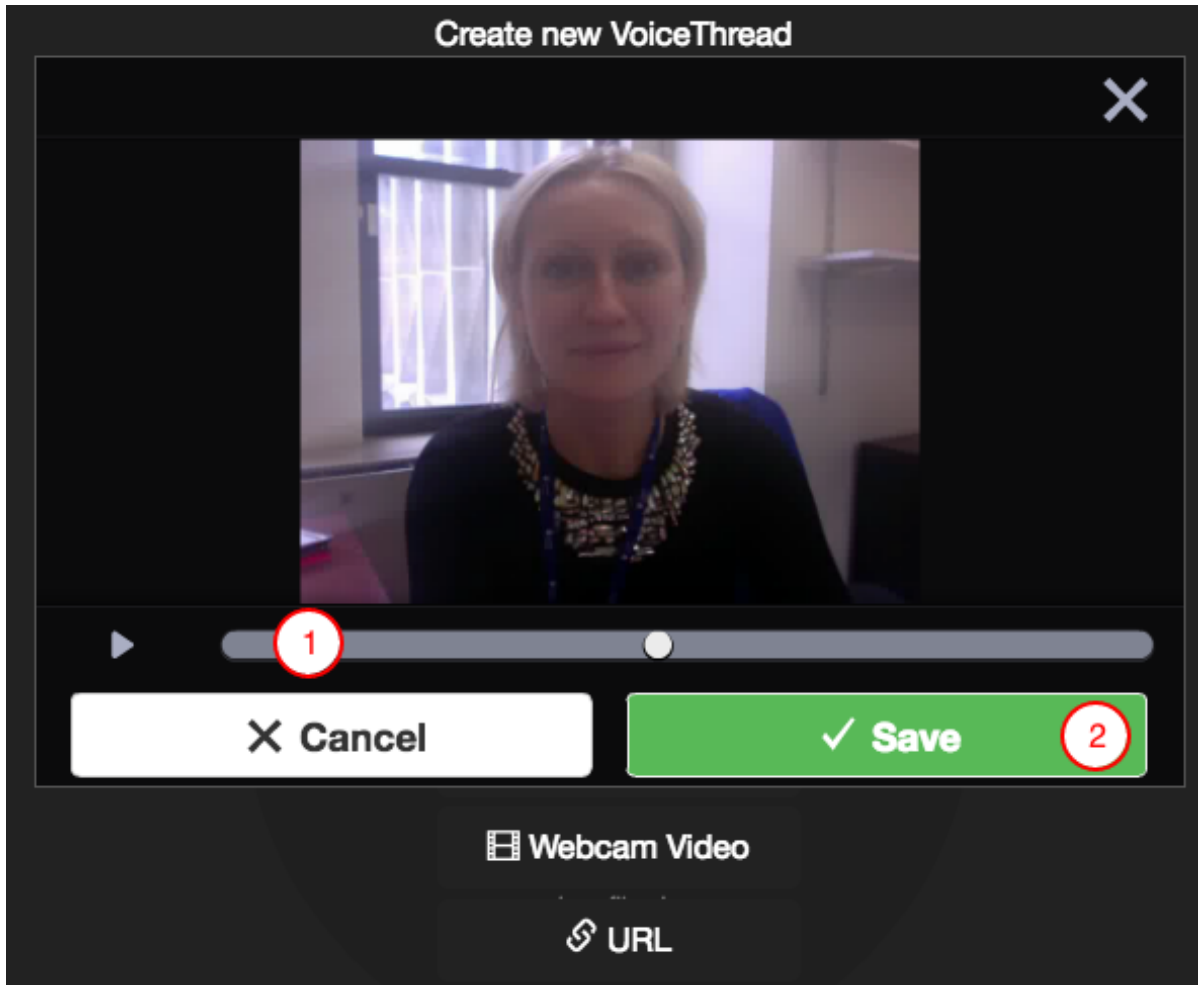
Record

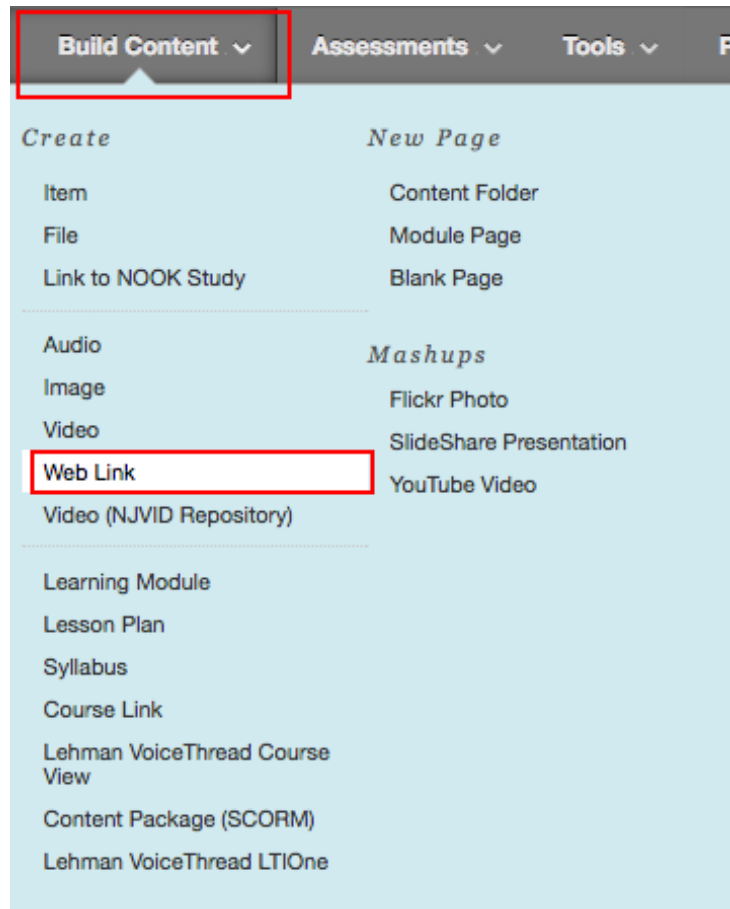
