



## Advanced Certificate in Clinical Mental Health Counseling

This advanced certificate program is designed for Individuals who have earned a Master's degree (of 60 credits) in School Counseling from Lehman College or another accredited institution. Individuals who complete the advanced certificate will meet the educational requirements for licensure as a clinical mental health counselor in New York State and be eligible to apply for a limited permit and take the National Clinical Mental Health Counselor Examination (NCMHCE). These requirements include 6 graduate courses, totaling 16 credits, and 600 hours of internship.

### Admissions Requirements

- Official transcripts from all post-secondary institutions attended
- Master's degree in School Counseling from an accredited 60-credit School Counseling program\*\*
- Minimum graduate school gpa of 3.0
- One letter of recommendation from an employer or faculty to serve as academic and/or character reference
- An essay that explains interest in pursuing this area of study and future career plans.
- Current resume
- An individual interview
- If educated in a country other than the U.S. review

Students who complete the program meet the educational requirements for licensure as a Clinical Mental Health Counselor (LMHC) in New York State, may apply for a Limited Permit, can sit for the National Clinical Mental Health Counselor Examination (NCMHCE), and begin accruing the required 3,000 supervised post-degree clinical hours for full licensure.
