The Advanced Certificate in Actuarial

Mathematics at Lehman is for individuals who have an undergraduate degree and are seeking the broad training needed to pursue this career. The program focuses on probability, financial mathematics, and mathematical statistics. Courses are organized to help students prepare for the Actuarial P and Actuarial FM Exams. The program also includes a course recognized by the Society of Actuaries for Validation by Educational Experience (VEE) credit.

Did you know:

- » Actuaries work mainly for insurance companies, and sometimes for the government or as contractors.
- » In May of 2020, the median salary for actuaries was \$111,030 per year, or \$53.38 per hour.*
