A LITTLE HISTORY LESSON



- BMCC's [Academic Advisement & Transfer Center](#) was established in 1994 with a staff of one, the coordinator of academic advising
- Almost 30 years later, staff of 49 (including the Director)
 - Provide academic & transfer advisement to unaffiliated students
 - We see approximately 16,500 students per enrollment cycle
 - Size of the staff helps with effective academic and transfer advisement

AN ADVISEMENT SESSION

- What is the student's ultimate career goal?
- What 4-year institution would they like to/ plan to attend, after BMCC?

AN ADVISEMENT SESSION (CONT'D)

- Talk about transfer from the very beginning
 - We are 1 of only 2 CUNY C.C. that houses both it academic & transfer advisement in one Center
 - Transfer timeline
 - Reality Based Transfer Planning
- ❖ Importance of early transfer planning and career exploration

TRANSFER TIMELINE

0-15

- Create a list of your various academic/career interest
- Meet with an advisor to start the development of an educational plan.

16-30

- What is a "**Best fit**" school?
- Develop a list of 5-7 schools that interest you based on your goals, interest, and values.

31-45

- Get your questions answered from your potential institutions.
- Finalize your list.
- Check-in with advisor "Graduation Audit"

46-60

- Submit transfer application and required forms.
- File for graduation.

REALITY BASED TRANSFER PLANNING

- What schools are they interested in?
- What cumulative GPA does the students have?
 - What is the GPA requirement for the program they are interested?
- Type of application?
- How far can they commute?
- Do they want to live on campus?
- If considering a SUNY or a private school, encourage to apply for scholarships. Have they started scholarship research?
 - BMCC scholarship resources

 - Allows students (and advisors) to see how courses will transfer to a specific CUNY institution for a specific program
